

**Anna Mary Alice (Hollenbaugh) Adams**, (3 Jul 1870 – 20 Jan 1908) Perry County Democrat, Wednesday, January 22, 1908

**Mrs. Harry Adams**, age 37 years, of Fox Hollow, Carroll Township, died Monday night very suddenly. She was in perfect health when she went to bed Monday evening. At midnight she was awake and talked with Mr. Adams. About three o'clock the baby cried and Mr. Adams spoke to his wife. She did not answer and when he laid his hand upon her and found she was dead. She had died right there beside him in bed sometime between midnight and three o'clock, evidently without a struggle. The physician pronounced the cause of death to have a stroke of apoplexy.

Mrs. Adam's maiden name was **Anna Mary Alice Hollenbaugh**, daughter of **Samuel Hollenbaugh**. She was born on July 3, 1870.

Five young children survived, the young baby being only a year old. The following brothers and sisters also survive; **John Hollenbaugh** of Shermansdale, **Sadie (Mrs. Elmer Leidigh)** Carlisle, and **Alma (Mrs. Morten Bear)** Carlisle.

Her remains will be interred in Reiber's Church Yard Cemetery."
