**Craig P. Albright Sr.**, 90, of Middletown, formerly of Palmyra, died Thursday, Oct. 11, 2012 in Frey Village Nursing and Rehab Center.

He was born Oct. 17, 1921 in Steelton to **Clayton** and **Margaret (Vanatta) Albright**.

He began his baking career at Glass's Pastry in Duncannon and retired from Milton S. Hershey School; was a graduate of Duncannon High School and Dunwoody College of Technology, Minneapolis, Minn.; an Army veteran of World War II; and a member of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church, Hershey, and American Legion Post 340, Duncannon.

He was past president of Perry County Christian Endeavor, a chaplain in the American Legion, a leader and participant in local school activities, delivered Meals on Wheels, and mentored many students from the Milton S. Hershey School. Along with his wife, he helped settle war refugees from Asia, the Balkans and Africa. In recognition for their efforts, they were nominated to receive WGAL's Jefferson Award, which recognizes exceptional volunteerism in the community.

He was the widower of **Anna L. Albright**.

Surviving are a son, **Craig P. Jr.** of Middletown; three daughters, **Janet A. Rudolph** of Coatesville, **Joyce A. Wright** of Zion, Ill., **Nancy K. Brown** of East Berlin; ten grandsons; a granddaughter; numerous great-grandchildren and three sisters, **Catherine Kingsborough** of Carlisle and **Norma Jones** and **Jessie Frye** of Duncannon.

He was preceded in death by a brother, **William B.**, and two sisters, **Jean Adams** and **Bettie Mae Bowshot**.

Services were held Oct. 16 in his church. Burial was in Union Cemetery, Duncannon.
