

**Lawrence Bair**, (Died 2 Mar 1937), Duncannon Record, Thursday, March 4, 1937; **Lawrence Bair** Dies; Burgess of Newport

**Lawrence Bair**, 65, burgess of Newport, suffered a stroke and died suddenly at his home Tuesday night while arranging to act as a pallbearer for his friend, **Dr. George Moyer**, dentist, who had been president of the Newport borough council for several years. **Dr. Moyer** died at his home Tuesday morning, following a stroke of apoplexy.

For more than twenty years **Bair** served as superintendent of St. Paul's Lutheran Sunday-school, he was a member of the Masons, and the Harrisburg Consistory. He had conducted a grocery store in Newport for many years.

In addition to his widow he is survived by three daughters, **Mrs. William Long**, Millersburg; **Mrs. Gaius Lefferd**, Altoona; **Mrs. John Baker**, Mifflin. **Mrs. John Weirick**, of Liverpool, and **Mrs. Bruce Kauffman**, of Akron, Ohio, are surviving sisters.

Funeral services will be conducted Friday afternoon at 2:00 at the Myers funeral home, Rev. L. Stoy Spangler, pastor of the Newport Lutheran Church, officiating. Interment will be made in the Newport Cemetery.
