

Theophilus Baker, (Died 26 Aug 1917), Patriot, Wednesday, August 29, 1917

Baker – Funeral services for **Theophilus Baker**, aged 64 years, who died Sunday evening at the home of his niece, **Mrs. Robert Wadsworth**, 1618 North Fourth Street, will be held this afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. E. A. Pyles of the Fifth Street M.E. Church officiating. **Mr. Baker**, for the last two years a retired railroad conductor for the Philadelphia Division of the Pennsylvania Railroad, saw thirty-five years of service. He is survived by a daughter, **Mrs. Edward Smucker**, 1012 North Third Street, two brothers, **S. H. Baker**, of Serrogode, Illinois; **George W. Baker**, of Mechanicsburg, and three sisters, **Mrs. Maria Long**, of Thompsontown; **Mrs. T. Zimmerman**, of Newport, and **Mrs. DeLancey**, of Newport. He was a member of the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen No. 42, Knights of Malta No 114, and Independent Order of Odd Fellows No. 160. Burial will be in the East Harrisburg Cemetery.
