

**David W. Barnes**, (2 Jul 1942 – 3 Nov 2012), Perry County Times, Saturday, November 17, 2012

David W. Barnes, 70, of Thompsontown died Saturday, Nov. 3, 2012.

He was born July 2, 1942 in Delaware Twp., Juniata County, to the late **Newell and Elizabeth (Hoffman) Barnes**.

He was a self-employed contractor; an Army veteran of the Vietnam War; twice served as commander of Thompsontown AmVets; instrumental in starting a trout derby for children; a member of American Legion Post 298, Millerstown Moose and Tennis Lodge 371 F&AM; along with his first wife, operated Greenwood Raceway; and enjoyed hunting, woodworking, arrowhead hunting, gardening and maintaining his pond.

He was the widower of **Nancy G. (Naylor) Barnes**, who died Nov. 3, 2006.

Surviving are his wife, **Leslie Landis Barnes**, whom he married Oct. 12, 2011; a daughter, **Wendy Barnes** of Newport; a son, **Robert** of Charlotte, N.C.; three grandsons, **Bryce Mullen**, **Nathan Mullen** and **David Barnes**; a great-grandson, **Zayden Barnes**; three stepchildren, **Terry Landis Jr.**, **Tammy Landis** and **Crystal Fry**; and three brothers, **Joe**, **Jim** and **Johnnie Barnes**, all of Thompsontown.

He was preceded in death by four brothers, **Paul**, **Jack**, **Harry** and **Thomas Barnes**.

Services were held Nov. 10, in Emmanuel Lutheran Church, North Mill Street, Thompsontown with the Rev. Mike Sigler officiating.
