

Betty J. (Sheaffer) Wilson Barninger, (20 Jun 1927 – 11 Jun 2009), Perry County Times, Thursday, June 25, 2009

Betty J. Wilson Barninger of Millerstown died Thursday, June 11, 2009 at Holy Spirit Hospital, Camp Hill.

She was born June 20, 1927 at Ickesburg to the late **Albert** and **Margaret (Scott) Sheaffer** of Landisburg.

She worked for the United Telephone Company in Loysville as a telephone operator for 12 years, she and her first husband operated the Perry County Home from November 1963 to November 1973, worked for the Perry County commissioners for two years and then drove bus for Tri-County for 10 years; graduated from Landisburg High School; and was a former member of Tressler Memorial Lutheran Church, Loysville, and a member of Ickesburg Fire Company and the ladies auxiliary, Ickesburg Ambulance Association and Eshcol Cemetery Association.

She was the widow of **Joe S. Wilson**, who died in January 1983, and **Robert F. Barninger**, to whom she was married a little more than four years when he died in 1994.

Surviving are a brother, **Wayne A. Sheaffer** of Loysville; three sisters, **Helen Smith** of Mechanicsburg, **Linda Stuber** of Hummelstown and **Shirley Nace** of Loysville; and several nieces and nephews.

A graveside service was held June 16 in Eshcol Cemetery with the Rev. David Peterson officiating.
