

**George Abraham Barrick**, (24 Nov 1875 – 2 Jun 1934), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians

**George Abraham Barrick**, aged 58 years, died Saturday evening at the home of his son-in-law and daughter, **Mr. and Mrs. Russell Turnbaugh**, at their farm in Oliver Township, after having been ill several months of heart trouble. He was a son of **William** and **Eliza (Pee) Barrick** and was born in Polecat Valley, Miller Township. As a young man he followed boating on the Penna canal, but for 31 years was stable boss at the Oak Extract plant, which was closed several years ago. His wife, who was **Miss Annie Swartz** of Marysville, died six years ago this month.

Survivors are his sisters and brothers: **Annie, Mrs. P O Sheibley**, Johnstown; **Bertha, Mrs. Lawrence Long**, Canada; **Pearl, Mrs. Perry Clouser**, and **Jennie, Mrs. Harry Arndt**, Harrisburg; **Irvin** of Newport, and **Orris**, East Newport. Surviving also are two daughters, **Nellie Kathryn, Mrs. E J Marion**, Akron, Ohio, and **Helen Eliza, Mrs. Turnbaugh**. Nine grandchildren survive. **Mr. Barrick** who was well known, here possessed a very likeable disposition and was a member of Newport Social Order of Owls, and Loyal Order of Moose. Funeral services Wednesday afternoon at the home with interment in Newport Cemetery.
