

Irvin Lewis Barrick, (7 Sep 1887 – 5 Sep 1935), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians

Irvin Lewis Barrick, 47, died last Thursday morning at his home in Juniata Heights after being ill eight months of a complication involving his heart. He was a son of **William** and **Eliza (Pee) Barrick** and was born in East Newport, having lived in this vicinity all his life excepting about three years spent in Pittsburgh and Johnstown. He was employed at the Lucknow car shop.

He and **Miss Grace Sheaffer** were married Sept 8, 1907 by Rev A F Weaver of the Evangelical Church.

In addition to his wife he is survived by a son **Gerald**, Newport; a daughter, **Arletta**, **Mrs. Chester Ebright**, Milton; three grandchildren and the following brother and sisters: **Perry O. Barrick**, East Newport; **Mrs. P. O. Shively**, Johnstown; **Mrs. Lawrence Long**, Peach River, Alberta, Canada; **Mrs. Harry Arndt**, Harrisburg. He was a staunch Democrat and a member of the Newport Social Order of Owls.

Services were at the home Sunday afternoon followed by interment in Newport Cemetery. Rev Earl S Kipp officiated and the following served as pallbearers: **Harry Smith**, **John Leonard**, **Morris Kipp**, **Joe R Sheaffer**, **Clarence Smith** and **John W.R. Campbell**.

The remains of **Mr. Barrick** were interred on his 28th wedding anniversary and the day before his 48th birthday anniversary. Friends and relatives came for the funeral from Harrisburg, Enola, Summerdale, Andersonburg, Center, Ickesburg, Eshcol, Milton, Blain, Stoneboro, Johnstown, Liverpool and Rutherford Heights.
