

**Joseph George Barrick**, (Dec 1885 – 22 Oct 1931), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians

**Joseph G. Barrick**, died suddenly in Philadelphia on Tuesday. He was a son of **George F.** (deceased) and **Lydia (Monmiller) Barrick**. He was born in Miller Township 46 years ago, but resided in East Newport with his parents until about 20 years ago when he went to Philadelphia, where he had since lived. He was married to **Miss Daisy McCoy** who with his mother and the following brothers and sisters survive: **Mrs. B. M. Smith**, Wilmington, Del.; **Mrs. J. R. Sauserman** and **Walter Barrick**, this place; **Mrs. Wm. Gussler**, Lewistown; **Charles F.**, of Philadelphia, and **Rodney** of Camden, N.J.

The body will be brought today to the home of his mother where funeral services will be held Saturday followed by interment in Newport Cemetery.
