

Samuel Wesley Barrick, (20 Dec 1871 – 22 Feb 1920, Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians

Samuel W. Barrick, 49 years old, died yesterday morning at his home, 630 Peffer Street.

Funeral services will be held tomorrow evening at 7:30 o'clock, the Rev Clayton H Ranck, of St. John's Reformed Church officiating. The body will be taken to Newport on Wednesday by Hoover and Son for burial.

Mr. Barrick is survived by his wife, **Martha**, one son, **Wesley**, his father, **John Barrick**, of Newport, and three brothers, **William** and **Melvin**, of Newport, and **Dennis**, of Harrisburg. He was in the employ of the Pennsylvania Railroad for nineteen years as a brakeman on the Middle division. He was a member of the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen No. 42, the Golden Eagles and the Junior American Mechanics.
