

**William M. Baum**, (Died 2 Apr 1912), Patriot, Thursday, April 4, 1912; **William Baum Dies At The Hospital – Was Seriously Ill for Nearly a Month With Brain Trouble - Funeral on Friday**

After suffering for more than three weeks from mental trouble, **William Baum**, aged 32, a brakeman on the Pennsylvania Railroad, died Tuesday at the State Hospital.

Nearly a month **ago Mr. Baum** began to act strangely and did not report for work as usual. His condition grew rapidly worse, and he was taken to the State Hospital. Contrary to the expectations of the physicians, he sank rapidly and grew so weak that all hope of recovery was given up.

The body was taken to his home in Marysville yesterday afternoon, where it will be prepared for burial by Undertaker Deckard. Interment will be made in Grier's Point Cemetery tomorrow afternoon. The Rev. Mr. Pyler, of York County, will officiate.

Mr. Baum is survived by his **wife** and his parents, **Mr. and Mrs. Jessie Baum**.
