

**Amos J. Beatty**, (3 Oct 1834 – 29 Jan 1912), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians

**Amos J. Beatty**, age 78 years, 2 months and 28 days, died at his home in Newport, Tuesday morning of this week from a complication of diseases. The deceased was a son of the late **John W.** and **Anna Maria (Kayler) Beatty** and was born on Oct. 3, 1834 and was aged 78 years 2 months and 28 days.

He was married July 4, 1860 to **Margaret C. (Hassinger) Beatty**, now deceased. To this union were born nine children, seven surviving. **Carrie S.** and **Robert C.** of Newport, **Mrs. L. F. Smith** of this place; **Catherine B.**, **Blake H.**, **Walter W.**, and **Earl E.**, of Philadelphia.

The deceased was a member of the Reformed Church and a member of the Masonic fraternity, No. 490 of Altoona, who will have charge of the funeral services which will be held in Newport, Thursday at 2 p.m. The deceased was a painter by trade; retired from the P.R.R. at Altoona, on passenger cars. He was a highly respected citizen, esteemed by all.
