

**Frank A. Belmont, M.D.**, (21 Feb 1921 – 24 Mar 2009), Perry County Times, Thursday, 2 April 2, 2009

**Dr. Frank A. Belmont**, 88, of New Bloomfield died Tuesday, March 24, 2009 at Bethany Village, Mechanicsburg.

He was born Feb. 21, 1921 in Steelton to **Charles** and **Kate (Megaro) Belmont**.

He was a graduate of Steelton High School, Mount St. Marys College and Georgetown University College of Medicine. He moved to New Bloomfield in 1947 to practice medicine, retiring in 1984.

He was a Navy veteran of World War II; a member of St. Bernard Catholic Church, New Bloomfield, New Bloomfield Lions Club, for which he enjoyed working with the stage crew for plays, New Bloomfield VFW Post 7463, New Bloomfield Fire Company, Sons of Italy and Knights of Columbus; coached teener league baseball; and enjoyed hunting, fishing, baseball and bowling and was an avid Penn State fan.

Surviving are his wife of 65 years, **Betty (Franks) Belmont**; six children, **Richard** of Florida, **Thomas** of Newport, **Barbara Henry** of Baltimore, Md., **Kate Montoya** of Texas, **Cecilia Hogg** of Oil City and **Frances Douglas** of Texas; a brother, **Arthur** of Virginia; 13 grandchildren; and seven great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a sister, **Esther Belmont**.
