

Peter Bernheisel, (29 Dec 1839 - 27 Sep 1904), Patriot, Wednesday, September 28, 1904; **Peter Bernheisel** Died Late Last Night

Peter Bernheisel, one of the best known architects of this city, and for all of his life a resident of Harrisburg, died about midnight at his home, Fourteenth and Derry Streets. **Mr. Bernheisel** had been very ill for some time.

Mr. Bernheisel belonged to a family which had lived in Harrisburg for years, and was much interested in the development of the city. He was seventy-one years of age and is survived by his wife, three sons and two daughters. One of his sons is President of Select Council **Charles H. Bernheisel**, with whom he was in business under the name of **Bernheisel and Son**.

Mr. Bernheisel drew many plans for buildings in Harrisburg, and was frequently called upon for his judgment in important work. He leaves a wide circle of friends.
