

**Mrs. Catherine (Moyer) Stone Bitner**, (Died 17 May 1910), The Perry County Democrat, May 23, 1910

**A Newsy Letter From This Fertile Part Of Perry County Is Reported For “The News”**

Southwest Saville, May 23. **Mrs. Catherine (Moyer) Stone Bitner**, and aged and highly respected resident of this place, died suddenly of heart failure on Tuesday, May 17, at 6:30 p.m. aged 77 years, 2 months and 12 days.

She was twice married. First, in 1849, to **John Stone**. To this union nine children were born, eight of whom survive her, as follows: **Henry**, Howe Township; **Mrs. George Welcomer**, Middletown, Dauphin County; **William**, Huntsdale, Cumberland County; **Andrew**, this place; **George**, near Sandy Hill; **Mrs. Samuel Swab**, Early; **Emanuel**, Carlisle Springs; **Mrs. James Egolf**, Centreville, Cumberland County. One son, **David**, is dead. She leaves 40 grandchildren and 17 great grandchildren.

Her second husband was **Nicholas Bitner**, to whom she was married in 1875. To this union no children were born. **Mr. Bitner** has been dead many years.

Funeral services were conducted at her late home on Friday morning by Rev. George A Royer of the Loysville Lutheran charge. The internment was in the new cemetery, at Loysville. The pall bearers or **David Reapsome, Benjamin Shope, Phillip Burket, Harvey Showers, William Ricedorf** and **John Flickinger**.

She was a kind and affectionate mother, and a friend to everybody who knew her. Her loss will be deeply felt by all her acquaintances.
