**Samuel H. Black**, 80, of Mechanicsburg died Friday, Nov. 11, 2011, at home.

He was born March 29, 1931 in Millerstown to the late **Andrew S. Black** and **Dorothy Harlan**.

He was superintendent of building and grounds at Mechanicsburg School District for 21 years and a former partner in S. H. Black & Son from 1985 to 2002; a member of Mechanicsburg Presbyterian Church and served on the board of trustees; former president of Mechanicsburg Borough Council and served on the park and recreation board; past president of the State Association of Boroughs; member of Mechanicsburg Club, Businessmen's League, Y's Men's Club, past president and district governor of the Kiwanis, West Shore BPOE, and Millerstown Family Order of Moose, Newport American Legion and Newport VFW and Carlisle Eagles 1299; and enjoyed his cabin along the Juniata River.

He was the widower of **Joanne M. Hyde Black**, who died Aug. 20, 2010.

Surviving are four daughters, **Susan Eagen** of Tennessee, **Margaret Woll** and **Constance Roland**, both of Mechanicsburg, and **Jessica Black** of California; a daughter-in-law, **Kierna Black** of Mechanicsburg; a sister, **Lois Ann Baumbach** of Florida; six grandchildren; and seven great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a son **Samuel Andrew**; a granddaughter, **Amy Woll**; and a brother, **Shuman Black**.

Services were held Nov. 21 in his church with the Rev. Myrtle McCall officiating. Burial was in Riverview Cemetery, Millerstown.
