

Sarah Ellen (Shatto) Black, (1 Aug 1849 – 28 Jan 1924), Duncannon Record, January 31, 1924

Mrs. William J. Black, page 75 years 5 months and 27 days, died at her home on N. Market St., Monday morning at an early hour from the effects of a stroke of paralysis suffered several weeks previous to her death.

The deceased was the daughter of **Mr. and Mrs. Joseph M. Shatto** and had been a resident in this place for more than 50 years. She was a member of the Presbyterian Church and was of a most estimable Christian character, a devoted wife and mother.

In addition to her husband she is survived by a son and daughter **Charles A. Black**, of New Cumberland, and **Mrs. D. F. Surfing**, of this place. Two sisters, **Mrs. James E. Wilson** and **Ms. Elizabeth M. Shatto**, of this place also survive.

Funeral services will be held at her late home Thursday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, Rev. Raymond H. Wilson pastor of the Presbyterian Church officiating.

Interment will be made at the Presbyterian Cemetery.
