

David Boyd, (15 Feb 1848 – 16 Aug 1916), Harrisburg Telegraph, August 18, 1916

Duncannon, Pa., Aug. 18. – **David Boyd** died at his home in South Market Square, here, on Wednesday evening from a stroke of paralysis, sustained several weeks ago. When a young man, **Mr. Boyd** followed farming in Allen Cove, Penn Township. Later he taught school for several years and was a bookkeeper for the Duncannon Iron Company. He was a tax collector for Duncannon borough but resigned that position a year ago on account of ill health. He is survived by his wife and two sons, **John T. Boyd**, of Harrisburg and **Hugh Boyd**, of Pittsburgh. Funeral services will be held tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock in charge of the Rev. Dr. George H. Johnston, pastor of the Presbyterian Church.
