

Jeremiah Brown, (4 Feb 1853 – 10 Apr 1935), Duncannon Record, Thursday, April 18, 1935

Jeremiah Brown, a highly respected citizen of Susquehanna Township, Juniata County, Pa., was born Feb. 4, 1853, and departed this life Wednesday, April 10, at 9:30 p. m., aged 82 years 2 months; and 6 days.

On April 16, 1878 the deceased was united in marriage with **Minerva Paige**. To this union were born five sons and two daughters. One son and one daughter preceded him in death. Deceased was a member of the St. James Evangelical Church for many years and in this faith he died.

The following survive: his widow who was stricken with paralysis on the day of the funeral services, four sons and one daughter, **Mrs. Minnie Boyer**, of Harrisburg; **Joseph**, of Donaldson, Pa.; **Charles**, Newport, Pa.; **Albert**, Millersburg, Pa.; **Simon**, at home, seven grandchildren and one great grandchild and a large circle of friends.

Services were held from the home and Linninger's Church near Oriental, Juniata County, Pa., Saturday afternoon, April 13th, and his body tenderly laid to rest in the cemetery adjoining the church.
