William C. Brunner, 95, of Fox Hollow Road, Shermans Dale died Tuesday, Jan. 5, 2010 in Carlisle Regional Medical Center.

He was born Aug. 30, 1914 in New Bloomfield to **William W.** and **Jane B. Forrer Brunner**.

He and his wife, **Goldie**, owned and operated the former Brunner's Community Food Store in Shermans Dale. He worked at Harrisburg Steel during World War II and was a general farmer; was a member of Young's United Methodist Church, Shermans Dale, and a charter member of Shermans Dale Fire Company and Shermans Dale Lions Club; and enjoyed bowling and playing pinochle.

He was the widower of **Goldie Stone Brunner**, who died in 1991.

Surviving are two sons, **W. Jack** of Carlisle and **Robert L.** of Shermans Dale; a daughter, **Bonnie McAlister** of Shermans Dale; six grandchildren; 14 great-grandchildren; and a great-great-grandson.

Services were held Jan. 8 in his church with the Rev. Gary Daugharty officiating. Burial was in the church cemetery.
