

Clara (McNaughton) Byers, (12 Aug 1874 – 30 Jun 1943), Perry County Times, July 14, 1943

Mrs. Clara Byers, 68 years 10 months and 18 days was found dead in her home at 1640 N. 3rd St., Harrisburg on Wednesday morning at 10 o'clock, June 30, 1943 when her husband, **Alfred Price (Colonel) Byers** returned from grocery shopping. The coroner Earl T. Grim pronounced death came at 9:05 a.m. due to a heart attack.

The funeral service was held Saturday, July 3 at 1:30 p.m. at the residence in Harrisburg with Charles E. Dugan funeral director in charge. The Rev. Joseph F. Gross of the Harris Street Evangelical Church officiated. Pallbearers were her four sons, burial was made in Newport Cemetery.

The deceased was the daughter of the late **Houston** and **Maria (Powell) McNaughton** and was born and Sugar Run Valley, Tuscarora Township, Perry County, PA. She was born on August 12, 1874. On the 20th day of November 1892 she married **Alfred P. Byers** and was married by the Rev. L. S. Colson. She was a member of the United Brethren Church, the Otterbein Chapel near Donnelly's Mills.

She was preceded in death by **two** daughters and **one** son. She is survived by her husband **Alfred P. Byers** and four sons and four daughters: **Walter D.** and **Harry J. Byers** of Duncannon, _____ **Byers** New Bloomfield; **Raymond R. Byers** Harrisburg; **L. C., Mrs. Paul E. Mullen** of Lebanon RD three; **Grace, Mrs. Brian Gibney** of Oxford; **Stella, Mrs. Russell Barry** of Middletown; **Helen, Mrs. Ralph Myers** of Newport; 17 grandchildren, one great-grandchild, one brother **George B. McNaughton** of Millerstown.
