

Daisy M. (Hess) Campbell, (23 May 1885 – 18 Mar 1921), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians

This community was sorry to learn of the death of **Mrs. Daisy Campbell**, which occurred on Friday night at 12 o'clock at the Harrisburg Hospital, following an operation. **Mrs. Campbell** was the widow of **Robert Campbell** who died August 30, 1920. She leaves two little boys, **Ellsworth** and **Larue Campbell**, their ages are 7 and 9 years. **Mrs. Campbell** was a daughter of the late **George** and **Kate (Bernheisel) Hess** and was 38 years old.

Mrs. Campbell was born and reared at Stony Point and had many friends who will miss her in the locality in which she lived. She was a fine neighbor always willing to do a favor. She was a faithful member of the United Evangelical Church at Stony Point.

The remains were brought on Saturday to her home near Stony Point for burial. The funeral was held on Tuesday morning at 10 o'clock, with services conducted in the United Evangelical Church by her pastor, Rev. L. E. Teter. Interment was made in the Stony Point Cemetery.
