

Daniel Ambrose Campbell, (27 Dec 1849 – 6 Mar 1901)

Daniel Ambrose Campbell, son of ex-County Commissioner **George Campbell**, died of cancer of the stomach on Tuesday at 10:00 a.m. at his home in Juniata township, having farmed his father's farm for the past few years. He was born in Newport, December 27, 1849, in a house that stood where the house now occupied by Jacob Bowers stands at Market and Third streets. He had been sick a year, and a hemorrhage Thursday night in which a pint of blood was discharged, indicated that he could not live long. He was married to Miss **Mary Jane Ehrhart**, who survives him, with an only child, **a son**. His mother died in 1893. His father survives him as do also his brothers, **Prof. John S. Campbell** and **Dr. G.W. Campbell**, of this place; **Samuel J.** and **J. Elias**, of Markelville; **Robert B.**, of Harrisburg, and **B.F.** of Philadelphia; and one sister, **Mrs. Jacob Kell**, of Harrisburg. Funeral services will be conducted by Rev. Edward D. Meixell at the house this morning at 10 o'clock: interment in the Newport Cemetery.
