
Isaiah Campbell. (25 May 1846 – 9 Jan 1908), Peoples Advocate and Press, January 15, 1908, New Bloomfield, PA



Isaiah Campbell, a highly respected citizen of Eshcol, died suddenly on last Saturday evening, aged about 62 years old. Mr. Campbell had been a sufferer with some form of organic stomach trouble for a long time and during the past summer was failing rapidly, but none of his family expected his death so soon. On Saturday night he complained of a pain in his chest. After retiring he appeared to be suffering some pain, when he became very quiet. Upon investigation he was found to be dead. Drs. Baker and Bryner were called as soon as possible and pronounced his death due to an acute indigestion. The deceased early in life became a member of the Lutheran Church at Eshcol and lived a consistent member of the same until his death. While living he served his community in various positions of trust. He was a school director of Saville Township for many years. In politics he was a Democrat, and a men to whom the entire community looked upon as a model citizen. A wife and five children- four sons and one daughter survive him.

The deceased will be interred in the Eschol Cemetery on Thursday afternoon. We extend to the bereaved family our sincere condolences and heard felt sympathy.
