

Elizabeth (Henry) Case, (18 Apr 1884 – 28 Mar 1969), Lebanon Daily News, Friday, March 28, 1969

Death this morning claimed **Mrs. Elizabeth H. Case**, widow of **Major Harry D. Case**, who was one of the city's most outstanding leaders of military affairs.

Mrs. Case who was 84 and a former Lebanon resident, died in the Hill Farm Nursing Home, Annville R.D. 1.

Major Case, a veteran of the Spanish American War and World War I, died on March 19, 1949.

Mrs. Case was a member of a well known and highly respected Lebanon County family. For many years she was active in community affairs.

She was the daughter of the late **George S. and Clara Matthews Henry**.

Mrs. Case was a member of Zion Lutheran Church and the auxiliaries of the American Legion and Good Samaritan Hospital.

Surviving is a sister-in-law, **Mrs. Margaret C. Henry**, Hershey, and several nieces and nephews.

At the time of his death, **Major Case** was the last member of the family of **Leffert H. Case**, a Civil War veteran, lawyer and prominent political leader of Northumberland County. His mother was a sister of **Maj.-Gen. J. P. S. Gebin**, this city, who was also a Civil War veteran, attorney and at one time lieutenant governor of the state.
