

David C. Charters, (Died 2 Jan 1909), Perry County Democrat; January 6, 1909

David Charters died at this home in Landisburg, Saturday morning, January 2, 1909 aged 77 years, 8 months, and 18 days. His death was due to the infirmities of his age.

David C. Charters was the youngest son of **William C.** and **Susan (Strawbridge) Charters**, his mother's family having emigrated from Ireland. The deceased was born in Landisburg and resided here until his death. He was a shoemaker by occupation, having gone to his trade at the age of 14 years. He served as Justice of the Peace of Landisburg borough for twenty years. **Mr. Charters** was an intelligent man and a good citizen and was a member of the Church of God for a number of years. He was married to **Jennie Deach**, of New Germantown. To them were born two children, **Susie**, who was the wife of **Zach E. Rice**, of this place, and **Charles D.** Both are deceased. **Mr. Charters** is survived only by his wife.

Funeral services will be held at his late residence Tuesday morning at 11 o'clock. Interment in the Landisburg Cemetery.
