

John R. Chilton, (26 Dec 1935 – 7 May 2009), Perry County Times, Wednesday, June 03, 2009

John "Jack" R. Chilton, 73, of Frederica, Del. died Thursday May 7, 2009 at Milford Hospital. He had been a resident of the Delaware Veterans Home in Milford, Del.

He was born Dec. 26, 1935 in Philadelphia to the late **Russell** and **Marion E. Chilton**, and moved to New Buffalo as a child. He was in the last class to graduate from Duncannon High School.

He was an Air Force veteran of the Vietnam War, serving a total of 28 years, retiring as a master sergeant. After retirement, he worked civil service for 15 years at Dover AFB, Del., and for five years for the State of Delaware Department of Developmental Disabilities, driving people to appointments.

Surviving are his wife of 49 years, **Sally A. Chilton**; a son **Kirk** of Frederica; a daughter, **Jody Chilton** of Cape Coral, Fla.; two brothers, Thomas of Weatherford, Texas, and Dr. Mark of Frederick, Md.; and three grandchildren, **Caitlyn Crouser** of Atlanta, Ga., and **Austin** and **Christian Chilton**, both of Frederica.

Burial was in Delaware Veterans Memorial Cemetery, Millsboro, Del. Torbert Funeral Chapels handled arrangements.
