Eleanor F. Fritz Chubb, 90, died Tuesday, Jan. 31, 2012 at her home in Newport.

She was born Dec. 26, 1921 in Snyder County to **Otto** and **Cora (Krytzer) Benner**.

She was retired from Piezo Crystal, Carlisle, and had worked in numerous dress factories; a member of St. Johns United Church of Christ, Markelsville, where she taught Sunday school for 35 years, and the DAV, where she served as chaplain; and loved to sew and crochet, do crafts, cook, gardening and write poetry. She was honored and published in the 1995 National Library of Poetry's "A Sea of Treasures" for her poem, "McKees Rocks."
