

Elmer L. Clegg, (1861 – 1891), Perry County Democrat, May 13, 1891

Died of Consumption-- **Mr. Elmer L. Clegg**, son of the late **Benjamin F. Clegg** of New Bloomfield, Perry County, Pa. died on Saturday at his home in Altoona, where he was in the employ of the Pennsylvania Railroad Company. His remains were brought here on Monday on the 1:30 train and interred in the cemetery. He was a member of Castle #27, Knights of the Mystic Chain, and a committee of six of his brother Knights accompanied the remains and acted as pall bearers. Their names were **N.G. Mason, Miles Kensinger, George R. Major, D.D. Higgins, C.S. Schlag, and C.L. Bonslough**. His mother, **Mrs. Rebecca Clegg**, his sister **Miss Mary** and his niece **Miss Mamie Clegg**, all of Altoona, attended the funeral. **Elmer** was born in this town where his boyhood days were passed. For some time he had been suffering from that dread disease consumption and on Saturday a hemorrhage from the lungs ended his life. He was aged 29 years and 6 months. **C.T. Clegg**, of this place, was his uncle, and **Mrs. William Clouser** of this town, his aunt.
