

J. Edward Clouser, (15 Dec 1893 – 18 Feb 1918), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians

J. Edward Clouser, age 24 years, 2 months, 12 days, and son of **Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Clouser** of this place,(New Bloomfield) died early this morning. He had been afflicted with pulmonary trouble for some years past and was gradually failing. He had been sleeping out on the upper porch and about 3 o'clock called to his mother, she hurrying to him and found him unconscious and dying from a profuse hemorrhage from the lungs.

The deceased was the son of **Joseph J. and Barbara E. (Kitner)** and was born in Centre Township, December 15, 1893. He had learned barbering but quit on account of ill health. He was held in high esteem by a large circle of friends and relatives.

He is survived by his parents and the following brothers and sisters; **Raymond** and **Frances**, Pearl City, Ill; **Hubers** in Alinda; **Mrs. D. Oscar Stoops**, Carroll Twp.; **John** at Camp Green, North Carolina, and **Mary Ellen** at home.

Funeral services were held at his late residence with Rev. Homer Knox, officiating and assisted by Rev. J.W. Weeter, interment in the cemetery.

Patriot, Friday, March 1, 1918 – J. E. Clouser Dies

New Bloomfield, Feb 18. – **J. Edward Clouser** died early this morning at the home of his father, **Joseph Clouser**, in this place. He is survived by his parents and six brothers and sisters, one of whom, **John Clouser**, is in the U.S. Service at Camp Green, N.C. Funeral services will be held at his home at 10:30 on Saturday morning. He was twenty-three years old.
