

**Mar Colburn**, (Died 24 Nov 1879), The Newport Ledger, Saturday, November 29, 1879

Monday morning last, just as the clock struck ten, little **son** of **Rev. N. W. Colburn**, of this place, closed his eyes and death. The little fellow suffered intense agony during his brief illness. The disease that carried him off was a membranous croup. He was a dear little fellow, and was always glad to see the writer, who was one of two men other than his father and brothers that little **Mar** would make up with. We sympathize with the bereaved parents, in as much as we at one time lost a loved one, a few days older than **Mar**, by the same disease. The funeral took place on Tuesday morning; internment at Danville, Pa., on Wednesday.
