

Frank H. Coleman, (13 Oct 1864 – 20 Jan 1940), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians

Frank H. Coleman, age 75 years, died at his home on William Street in the borough of Marysville, of a heart attack. He was a retired brakeman of the Pennsylvania Railroad, and retired January 1, 1930. He was a member of the Pacific Lodge No. 63, Independent Order of Odd Fellows, Baltimore, and Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen, Lodge No. 694.

Surviving are one daughter, **Sara Coleman**, at home, and three sisters. **Miss Tillie Coleman**, **Miss Sara Coleman**, and **Mrs. Mary Riber**, all of York.

Funeral services were held at 2 o'clock Wednesday afternoon in the Marysville Church of God, The Rev. G.W. Harper, pastor of the church officiating. Burial was in Chestnut Grove Cemetery.
