Patriot, Monday, April 30, 1906. Mr. Colestock's Funeral

The funeral services of **A. Ramsey Colestock**, who died Friday evening at the Harrisburg Hospital from injuries received at the Union Station by being run down by the Limited Express, will be held from the home, 1237 Chestnut Street, this morning at 9 o'clock. The services will be conducted by Rev. J. Ritchie Smith, pastor of the Market Square Presbyterian Church. The body will be sent to Duncannon for interment.
