John T. Conaway, 51, of Newville died Monday, Feb. 15, 2010, in Carlisle Regional Medical Center.

He was born Sunday, July 20, 1958, in Olney, Md., to **Joan (Clark) Conaway** of Newville and the late **Clifton D. Conaway**.

Since 1993, he and his wife continued the family business of owning and operating Pine Haven Christmas Tree and Livestock Farm in Newville, which was established in 1965. Richard Eberts** of Waynesboro; and two sisters-in-law, **Jane Eberts** of Carlisle and **Betsy Eberts** of Vero Beach, Fla.

Services were held Feb. 21 in Ewing Brothers Funeral Home, Carlisle, with the Rev. Jeanette E. Mater officiating.
