Dallas Eugene Cook, 74, of Duncannon died Thursday, Oct. 22, 2015, at home.

He was born Oct. 11, 1941, in Duncannon to **Mary M. (Bressler) Cook** of Duncannon and the late **Thomas W. Cook**.

He was a deputy officer for the Waterway Conservation Authority for 37 years and later retired from the Pennsylvania State Police, where he worked as a civilian in the maintenance department, Liquor Control Board and the National Air Guard, Middletown, accumulating more than 22 years of working with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; a 1960 graduate of Susquenita High School; and a member of Duncannon Sportsmen's Club and the River of God Church, Enola.

In addition to his mother, surviving are a companion, **Patricia A. Cook** of Duncannon; a nephew, **Steven M. Kisner**; and two great-nephews, **Zachary Kisner** and **Justice Nelson**.

He was preceded in death by a sister, **Shirley Stoner**.

A service was held Oct. 28 in Ronald C.L. Smith Funeral Home, Duncannon, with the Rev. Tim Halbfoerster officiating. Burial was in Union Cemetery, Duncannon.
