Helen L. Cressler, 95, a resident at the Cottages of Luther Ridge, Chambersburg, died Monday, Dec. 3, 2012, at her home.

She was born March 4, 1917, in Shippensburg to **Clyde A.** and **Agnes C. Shoffner Laughlin**.

She was a homemaker; a 1935 graduate of Shippensburg High School; a member of St. Luke's Lutheran Church, Chambersburg, Shippensburg Historical Society, Shippensburg and Newport Civic Club, and Fort Morris A.A.R.P. 2525, Shippensburg.

She was the widow of **Walter L. Cressler**, who died in 1965.
