Calvin W. Cromleigh, 91, of Duncannon, died November 15, 2008 in Holy Spirit Hospital.

He was born November 28, 1916, in Duncannon to the late **John** and **Laura (Fry) Cromleigh**. He graduated from Duncannon High School in 1934, attended Duncannon Presbyterian Church, and served in the U.S. Army during World War II in central Europe and Persia. Even though Calvin never had any children of his own, he was involved continuously with the Boy Scouts in Duncannon holding numerous positions for over 78 years.

After retiring as a partner of Cromleigh Brothers in 1982, Calvin still enjoyed going to the Wagon Wheel Rod & Gun Club camp with his camp buddies, and trips to Berrier's Island to follow his passion of hunting and fishing. He also was very active in the Duncannon Sportsman's Club, attending meetings and block shoots.
