Olive Virginia Crull, 90, of Landisburg died Saturday, March 26, 2011 in ManorCare Health Services, Carlisle.

She was born March 30, 1920 at New Bloomfield to **Jacob Sherman Kitner** and **Florence May (Frye) Kitner**.

She was retired from Pennsy Supply, Harrisburg, and during World War II worked at the Defense Depot, New Cumberland, later transferring to the Navy Depot, Mechanicsburg; a 1938 graduate of the former New Bloomfield High School; a member of Shiremanstown United Methodist Church and attended Kennedy's Valley Church of God, Landisburg; and a member of The Perry Historians, Newport, and Golden Age Club, Loysville.

She was the widow of **Scott L. Crull**, who died May 1, 2009.

Surviving are a son, **Bradley S.** of Dillsburg; two grandchildren, **Josh Washburn** and **Jillian Crull**; and many nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by five brothers and six sisters.

Services were held March 30 in Nickel Funeral Home, Loysville, with the Rev. Malcolm E. Martin officiating. Burial was in Landisburg Cemetery.
