

Scott L. Crull, (28 May 1923 – 1 May 2009), Perry County Times, Thursday, May 7, 2009

Scott L. Crull, 85, of Kennedy's Valley Road, Landisburg died Friday, May 1, 2009 at home.

He was born May 28, 1923 at Landisburg to the late **Arthur L.** and **Sara E. Rhule Crull**.

He retired as a guard at the Camp Hill State Prison with 30 years of service; was an Army veteran of World War II, serving in four campaigns, Northern France, Central Europe and Rhineland, and the recipient of many awards, Le Croix de Guerre with Bronze Star, Good Conduct Medal, GO 4 Headquarters Special Trs 12th Army Group 13, Northern France Campaign Star, Central Europe Campaign Star, Rhineland Campaign Star, Ardennes Campaign Star and the EAME Ribbon; and a member of Kennedy's Valley Church of God, life member of Landisburg VFW, Landisburg Ambulance Association and Landisburg Fire Company.

Surviving are his wife of 53 years, **Olive Kitner Crull**; a son, **Bradley S.**; a brother, **Melvin D.**; two grandchildren; and many nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by a sister and six brothers.

Services were held May 5 in Nickel Funeral Home, Loysville, with the Rev. Malcolm E. Martin officiating.

Burial was in Landisburg Cemetery.
