**DELANCY, MARY, MRS.**, widow of **Francis Delancy** and pioneer, was born in Chester County, Penn., Aug. 18, 1793; when she was about one year old, her parents moved to Perry County, Penn. She was married in 1810, and remained in Pennsylvania until 1828, when she with her husband and family came to Ohio; they were two years in Jackson Township; they then removed to where she now lives this was about 1831. She lives with her son, **Peter Delancy**; she is active, for such an old lady; she is one of the oldest residents of the township; she has had nine children, seven of whom are living, the youngest being 51 years of age.
