New Bloomfield, Pa., Dec 7. – **Charles L. DePugh**, recorder of Perry County, died suddenly at his home here yesterday at noon. **Mr. DePugh** was 64 years old and formerly lived at Duncannon.

New Bloomfield, Pa., Dec. 8. – Register and Recorder **Charles L. DePugh**, who died on Wednesday night from heart failure, had been in ill health for several years. He had been confined to his bed several weeks ago, but had been partly recovered.

**Mr. DePugh** was a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church of Duncannon. He was serving his second term as register and recorder of Perry County. He is survived by his wife, a daughter, **Mrs. Blanche Kluck**, and two sons, **Allen DePugh**, of Duncannon, and **William DePugh**, of Marysville.

Funeral services will be held at the Methodist Episcopal Church at Duncannon tomorrow morning, with burial in the Duncannon Cemetery.
