

Samuel Derick, (Died 7 Sep 1935), Duncannon Record, Thursday, September 12, 1935

Samuel W. Derick, aged 64 years died at his home in Harrisburg, Saturday morning.

Deceased was a son of the late **Mr. and Mrs. Christian Derick** and was born and reared in this place. When quite young he secured employment as a trainman on the Middle Division of the Pennsylvania Railroad and at the time of his death had an unbroken service of forty-six years, his last position being that of freight conductor. He was a member of the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen.
