

**John Dick**, (9 May 1833 – 9 May 1913), Perry County Democrat, May 24, 1913

**John Dick**, one of the good old citizens of Carroll Township, died very suddenly at the home of his son **Edward**, near Sterrett's Gap, about three o'clock Saturday afternoon.

He had been working the day before and on Saturday after eating his dinner, said that he did not feel very well and that he was going to lie down for a while. About three o'clock one of the members of the family went into his room and found that he was dead. Death was due to heart failure.

**Mr. Dick** was born May 9, 1833, and was therefore aged 80 years, and 1 day at the time of his death. He was married fifty-one years ago to **Miss Arabella Drexler**, of Kennedy's Valley. Their surviving sons and daughters are; **Mary (Mrs. Theo Brownawell)**, Sterrett's Gap; **Mrs. Susan Zeigler**, Steelton; **Scott Dick**, Shermans Dale; **Edward**, at home; and **Mrs. Annie Shenley** of Nevada.

The deceased was a member of the United Brethren Church. He was a farmer by occupation and was a fine man, having the respect and esteem of all who knew him.

The funeral took place yesterday, the service being conducted by his pastor, Rev. Harry Boyer and burial was at Young's Church.
