

Catherine M. (Stroup) Dietz, (16 Sep 1931 – 27 Mar 2011), Perry County Times, Monday, April 11, 2011

Catherine M. “Cass” **Dietz**, 89, of Selinsgrove died Sunday, March 27, 2011 at the Manor at Penn Village, Selinsgrove. She was a resident of Liverpool for 40 years.

She was born Sept. 16, 1921 in Richfield to **McClellan** and **Mary (Clotfelter) Stroup**.

She was employed as a seamstress in Richfield, Millerstown and retired from Eileen Hope Garment Factory, Liverpool, and after retirement cleaned houses until age 72; attended Gordon’s Grammar School, Buckwheat Valley; associated with Christian Union Church, Mt. Pleasant Mills; and enjoyed gardening, singing old hymns and being at Lowe’s Restaurant, and was a great cook and gifted seamstress.

She was the widow of **Lawrence Jacob Dietz**, who died March 19, 2003.
