

**Edward W. Dissinger**, (13 Sep 1872 – 14 May 1924), Duncannon Record, Thursday, May 22, 1924

**Edward W. Dissinger**, aged 52, employed as a Pennsylvania Railroad, trainman for the last thirty years, died at his home in the Cove shortly after noon Wednesday of last week.

The deceased was a son of the late **John** and **Fannie (Mussleman) Dissinger** and was born at Marysville, later residing in Harrisburg and the Cove. He has been ill for several months of diabetes. His **widow, son** and **daughter** survive.

Funeral services were held Saturday afternoon at the late home, Rev. J. O. Weigle, pastor of the Marysville Church of God officiating. Interment was made in the Chestnut Grove Cemetery, Marysville.
