

Jack L. Dobyys, (6 Aug 1934 – 3 Jun 2011), Perry County Times, Monday June 20, 2011

Jack L. Dobyys, 76, of Shamokin Dam died Friday, June 3, 2011 at home.

He was born Aug. 6, 1934 at Reedsville to the late **William** and **Esther (Reisinger) Dobyys**.

He was employed as a milkman by the former Halls Dairy that later became Harrisburg Dairies; a member of Victory Baptist Church, Selinsgrove; and a sports fan, especially of the New York Yankees and Boston Celtics.

He was the widower of **Viola J. “Deanie” (Williamson) Dobyys**, who died July 30, 2008.
