

Albert Leonard Dorwart, (Died 6 Jan 1917), Patriot, Monday, January 8, 1917. Albert E. Dorwart Dies. Son of Archdeacon is Victim of Pneumonia at Newport.

Newport, Jan 7. – **Albert L. Dorwart**, a son of **Archdeacon** and **Mrs. William Dorwart**, died at his home here Saturday from typhoid pneumonia, which he contracted while on a visit to his parents over the Christmas holidays. He was 22 years old, and besides his parents, is survived by a sister, **Miss Elizabeth Dorwart**, two brothers, **Fred**, who is located with the American troops at El Paso, and **George M.**, of St. Stephens College, at Annandale-on-the-Hudson.

The funeral services will be held Thursday afternoon at two o'clock from the Episcopal Church here, and will be conducted by Bishop Darlington, of Harrisburg.

Mr. Dorwart graduated from State College last summer, and during his four years at school there became prominent in athletics. Last fall he returned from college, where he was acting secretary of the Young Men's Christian Association.
