Larry E. Dromgold, 79, of Camp Hill died Thursday, Sept. 29, 2011 at Harrisburg Hospital.

He was born Jan. 24, 1932 in Blain to the late **David C.** and **Margaret J. (Gutshall) Dromgold**.

He was retired from Highmark with 28 years of service, and immediately after college worked for CCNB (PNC) as manager and assistant cashier of the East Pennsboro office; a graduate of Elizabethtown College and Blain Union High School; an Army veteran, serving in Alaska; a member of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church, Camp Hill, where he was an usher, Sunday school teacher and a member of the Bible study, Koinonia Group and Men of Trinity, a past president of the West Shore Lions Club, member of Camp Hill American Legion, New Cumberland VFW 7415, a mason with Robert Burns Lodge 464, member of the Scottish Rite, Zembo Shrine, Legion of Honor, member of Officers Club of the Navy Depot, and an assistant Scoutmaster; and a fan of the Pittsburgh Pirates.

Surviving are his wife of 44 years, **Joyce (Shenk) Dromgold**; a son, **David Clark Dromgold** of Camp Hill; and three nieces and five nephews.

He was preceded in death by three sisters, **Helen D. Smith**, **Isabel D. Ogden** and **Roxie D. Morrow**; and a brother, **C. Richard Dromgold**.

Services were held Oct. 5 in his church with pastors Glenn Ludwig and Nancy Easton officiating. Burial was in Blain Cemetery.
