

David Milligan Duncan, (31 May 1878 – 11 Jun 1949), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians, June 1949

David M. Duncan, died June 11, 1949. He was born May 31, 1878 and was aged 71 years and 11 days.

He was the son of **Samuel** and **Mary Duncan** and is survived by his wife **Pearl (Sheibley) Duncan**, and the following children: **Emma (Mrs. Glenn Kerr)**, and **Elwood**, on the homestead; and **David**, of Spring Township; also by two brothers, **Thompson**, of Chicago, Ill., and **Hess**, of Hazelton, Pa., and one sister, **Annie Duncan**, of Landisburg, Pa., and seven grandchildren.

On July 2nd last, **Mr. Duncan** ,et with an accident while unloading hay, falling from the top of the load upon the ground floor, fracturing several vertebrae; an accident from which he never recovered. He had the best medical care that could be procured and the kindest nursing that tender, loving hands could render. Not only by his devoted wife, but by his highly respected daughter-in-law, who apparently just seemed at home in the sick room, not only trying to alleviate the pain but to cheer his suffering.

He was a very, very patient sufferer; only a Christian gentleman of the highest type with the strongest fortitude could have endured the pain he must have suffered without a murmur

Funeral service were conducted in St. Peter's Evangelical Reformed Church on Wednesday morning at 10:30 o'clock. His pastor, the Rev. Paul R. Wright, officiated, assisted by Rev. Johns.
