

**Maude (Shearer) Duncan**, (8 Feb 1891 – 7 May 1940), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians, May 1940

Duncannon, May 8. – **Mrs. Maude Shearer Duncan**, wife of **W. Stewart Duncan**, president of the Duncannon National Bank, died of a heart attack last night during a Ladies Night program of the Duncannon Lions Club at the high school here. She was 49 years old.

**Mrs. Duncan**, who was active in church and civic affairs of the borough, died almost instantly in spite of the efforts of physicians attending the club event at the high school building to revive her. Dr. John Romig and Dr. Fred B. Hooper applied artificial respiration.

**Mrs. Duncan**, who had not been in the best of health for about a year, was sitting beside her husband when she suddenly slumped in her chair. She collapsed a short time after the entertainment began in the school auditorium.

She was a member of the Presbyterian Church, and was active for many years in the work of the Duncannon Women's Club, Garden Club and the Duncannon Auxiliary of the American Red Cross. Besides her husband, she is survived by her parents, **Mr.** and **Mrs. Charles E. Shearer**, of Duncannon, and a niece, **Patricia Jean Duncan**, also of this place.

Funeral service will be held Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock, Standard Time, at the residence on Market Street, with the Rev. Allen Bowe, pastor of the Duncannon Presbyterian Church, officiating. Burial will be made in the Presbyterian Cemetery at Duncannon.
